Mr. Ferguson has spent more than 30 years in education as a teacher and administrator. Among other subjects, he has taught strings, vocal, keyboard and band music in high schools in Toronto and Alliston. Mr. Ferguson is a former Head of Music at Banting Memorial H.S. and at North Toronto Collegiate. He has also served as a string adjudicator at numerous music festivals across southern Ontario, and has served as a clinician at OMEA conferences and has authored articles for the OMEA Journal.

As a performer, Mr. Ferguson has played with many orchestras in southern Ontario. He is a past concertmaster and soloist with the East York Symphony in Toronto, first violinist of the Artemis String Quartet, and member of the Koffler Chamber Orchestra.

Mr. Ferguson is currently the Music Director of the National Music Camp of Canada, which is held every August on the shores of Lake Couchiching. He has recently retired as a Principal with the Toronto District School Board and plans to devote more time to performing and teaching violin.
