Ken Hazlett is a graduate from the University of Toronto, Faculty of Music where he studied tuba with Charles Daellenbach, one of the members of the Canadian Brass. After graduating from the University of Western Ontario, Faculty of Education, he began his teaching career with the Toronto District School Board in 1981 as an Itinerant Music Teacher. For many years, he was an avid performer in the Toronto area. Some of his credits include performing with the Toronto Mendelssohn Choir as a singer, and with the Etobicoke Youth Orchestra and the Etobicoke Philharmonic as a tuba player. In 1982, Ken founded the Etobicoke Youth Band and has been with EYB ever since. For over 15 years Ken has also conducted at Music By the Lake, formerly the Toronto Music Camp, for the Toronto District School Board. Currently, he teaches at Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute in Toronto.
