Margot Jewell holds an ARCT diploma in Violin Performance from The Royal Conservatory of Music and a Bachelor of Music from McMaster University where she won the Governor's Entrance Scholarship and several other University scholarships. Her teachers include Marta Hidy, McMaster University, Victor Martin, University of Toronto, and Shinichi Suzuki, the Talent Education Institute, Matsumoto Japan.

Ms. Jewell is active as a performer, adjudicator and clinician. She has performed with orchestras such as the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra and the Aradia Baroque Ensemble, and has adjudicated for festivals such as the London Kiwanis Music festival, the Brantford Kiwanis Festival and the Hamilton Kiwanis Festival. She has also led masterclasses on topics such as Performing Bach Solo Sonatas and Partitas. Ms. Jewell has taught for the Hamilton Suzuki School of Music, and currently teaches for the Etobicoke Suzuki School of Music, where she acts as director, and the Etobicoke School of the Arts. Ms. Jewell is also a member of the Suzuki Association of the Americas, the Suzuki Association of Ontario (where she was past board member) and the Toronto Musicians' Association.
