Since 2005 she has directed five different productions for the school including The Miracle Worker and this year's production of Les Miserables.

Jenn is a theatre veteran who started acting at the age of four. Jenn has performed in more than 50 different stage plays and has appeared on television and in commercials. She has played many varying roles on stage. Her favourites include Lucy in You're a Good Man Charlie Brown, Emily in Our Town, Sylvia (the dog) in Sylvia, and Abigail Williams in The Crucible. When not performing in theatre Jenn and her husband run a Flying Trapeze school. Jenn is a flyer and Tim is a catcher. Last summer Camp Wahanowin was the first residential camp in Ontario to have a Flying Trapeze, both Jenn and Tim were excited to get the program up and running for this year's full time program during Wahaonwin.
