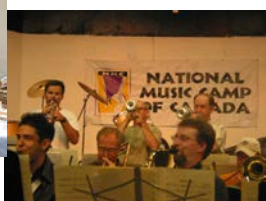

News Flash from NMC

National Music Camp of Canada (NMC) is pleased to offer a unique professional development opportunity for Arts Educators in August of this year. NMC has been running for 53 years on the shores of Lake Couchiching across the lake from Orillia and just up the road from Casino Rama.

NMC offers a variety of programs including Band, Strings, Orchestra, Jazz (includes vocal jazz at Senior camp), Music Theatre, Beginner Instruments (Band and Strings – Junior Camp only), Suzuki Strings (Junior Camp only) and Beginner to Advanced Acoustic Guitar.

We are inviting you to attend an “Educators Day at Camp” during our Junior Division Camp (campers completed Gr. 3 – Gr. 8) on Wednesday, August 23rd or during our Senior Division Camp (campers completed Gr. 8 – Gr. 12) on Wednesday, August 30th.

You may choose to come for the whole day or part of the day, as you wish. The day will look something like this:

You may arrive at any time after 8:15 a.m. and check in at the main office where you will be given a camp map and schedule for the day.

- *9 - 11 a.m. Visit classes and take in the work of our faculty and music staff, and perhaps pick up some repertoire ideas. There is a break in the middle and you may choose to move to a different group.*
- 11:15 - Lunch Tour the facilities with camp staff to get a feel for the site and atmosphere.*
- Lunch Join us in the dining hall to experience the best camp food anywhere!*
- *2 - 4 p.m. More music and theatre activities to see and hear so feel free to move around camp and take advantage. Again a break in the middle allows you to move freely to different areas of camp.
NB - the timing of classes in the senior camp may be slightly different than junior.
- 4:15 p.m. Meet in our Theatre with our faculty and admin team for a quick Q & A and casual conversation.*
- Dinner Join us again in the dining hall!*
- Concert Every evening after dinner we have a short faculty concert for the entire camp in our Theatre.*

I hope you will be able to join us on one or both of these days. Some of our classes are sectionals or group lessons so feel free to bring an instrument and join in if you wish!

Please note that we do not have facilities to accommodate overnight guests at camp, however there are a number of hotels in the area. Numbers are limited so **reserve your spot** by emailing me at mike@nationalmusiccamp.com and indicate which date(s) you'd like to join us!
