

NATIONAL MUSIC CAMP OF CANADA SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

The National Music Camp School Partnership Program (SPP) is a win/win relationship between NMC and participating schools. School Music Departments as well as their students will be rewarded for having music students attend camp.

NMC is a wonderful experience for music students personally and at the same time benefits all music programs. Students begin school fresh off a focused and intensive music experience that gives each individual more confidence and skill on their instrument. With the added financial incentive of the NMC School Partnership Program, both students and your school's program benefit even more.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Music teachers register for the program by filling out the appropriate SPP enrollment form **online**. NMC information is available for download here. If hardcopy material is perferred, please contact the camp office.
- 2. Teachers are asked to inform students of the NMC experience and provide material to all those interested.
- 3. Students from your school that attend NMC the following summer (at the end of the current school year), will receive a discount off their camp fees. A school needs 2 students to qualify.
- 4. Depending on the final number of students attending camp from the registered SPP school, the school music program will receive a financial reward.
- 5. The details for student discounts and financial rewards for schools are outlined in the following chart:

Number of Students	Camp Fee Discount	School Music Dept. Reward
2 to 5	\$25	\$100
6 to 10	\$50	\$200
11 to 15	\$75	\$400
16 to 20	\$100	\$750
21 or more	\$125	\$1000

- 6. For both students and schools to receive the fiancial benefits of the SSP, the Music Teacher must submit a list of NMC registered students to the NMC office by e-mail, fax or mail by June 20th of the current school year.
- 7. The Camp Fee Discount will be applied to the students' statement based on the number of students that have registered for camp from your school by June 1st. The School Music Department Reward will be issued to the school in September following camp and will be based on the total number of students that attend camp from your school (and that are registered by **June 1st**).
- 8. There is no cost to the school or students to register and participate in the School Partnership Program.
- 9. All SPP schools will be contacted to confirm participation in the SPP.
