The Staff Scholarship Fund was established in 1996 by the staff of NMC to provide financial assistance to talented young musicians from low-income families who would not otherwise be able to attend camp. Funding comes from staff and faculty donations, from camp activities and from public donations made at the end-of-camp Open House concerts. In 2009, it was renamed in memory of Matthew Ferguson, who had spent his life at camp and was an ardent supporter of the Fund.

Please Read Carefully:

- The Staff Scholarship Fund cannot be combined with any other NMC Scholarships or Matching Grants.
- Applications that meet the Government of Canada Low Income Family Guidelines are prioritized.
- Returning campers who have received a Staff Scholarship in the past are permitted to apply for funding in subsequent years.
- A completed camper application and deposit <u>MUST</u> be submitted online in order for a scholarship application to be considered.
- A copy of last year's Tax Return must be included with your scholarship application (summary page only "statement of remuneration paid").
- All applicants will receive a letter in May with an update on their scholarship status.
- If funds are still available after the first round has been awarded, late applications will be considered. Once the deadline has passed, please contact
 the office before starting an application.

- Have you completed the entire MFMSSF application form? (3 pages)
- Have you submitted your NMC camper registration form online at <u>www.nationalmusiccamp.com</u> and provided a deposit?
- Have you enclosed a copy of last year's Tax Return? (summary page only "statement of remuneration paid")
