National Music Camp is run by a non-profit, non-sectarian foundation and is located on a 100-acre site on the shores of Lake Couchiching, 90 minutes north of Toronto. Since 1965, young musicians have come to enjoy a challenging music experience balanced with a wide range of recreational activities.

COUNSELLING STAFF

Our staff love kids. Recreational Staff plan and run all the recreation programs and the evening programs. Music Staff work with the campers in their large groups, offer small group and individual lessons.

Our enthusiastic and dedicated Music Staff come mostly from University and College music programs from across Canada. This includes individuals who are certified music teachers and enrolled in teacher's college. Our energetic Recreation Staff are often in Recreation and Leisure programs here or abroad.

FACILITIES

NMC is always enhancing and improving its facilities. We take pride in our environment having spacious clean and comfortable cabins with cozy bunk beds, bathrooms and showers in cabins, spectacular Concert Hall for faculty and camper concerts, 7 "Rec" Halls for large rehearsals, 25 break out buildings for ensemble groups, beautiful waterfront with an expanded beach, rustic and spacious Dining Hall overlooking the lake, top notch Health Care and medical facilities as well as over 20 amazing camp activities including a full water park, tubing, ropes course, climbing wall, zipline and a circus trapeze!

FACULTY

More than 60 professional performing artist / teachers make up our Faculty. Orchestra musicians, inspiring elementary, secondary school and university teachers, freelance, musicians and private studio teachers come together to provide large group, one-on-one and small group instruction. The Faculty perform every night in our state-of-the-art theatre, allowing the campers to be up close and personal to the musical experience.

Campers in both camps have access to a full range of recreational activities such as swimming, canoeing, kayaking, arts and crafts basketball, volleyball, trapeze, tennis, ropes, waterpark zip line and MORE!

PROGRAMS

Junior Division is for students ages 9-13, completing grades 3-8*. We offer band, strings, beginning instruments (wind, brass, percussion, strings and guitar) suzuki strings, classical and acoustic guitar, musical theatre, jazz band, ukulele and drumline.

Campers in the band / orchestra, suzuki strings or junior jazz programs come with at least one year's experience.

Campers can participate in the beginning instrument program, musical theatre and beginning acoustic, classical guitar, ukulele and drumline programs with no experience.

Senior Division is for students ages 14-18 completing grades 8*-12. We offer band, orchestra, jazz, jazz vocal, acoustic and classical guitar, musical theatre, ukulele, drumline and fiddle. We also have an intermediate jazz program for students completing grades 7 and 8. In addition, we have a camp wide chorus and offer electives in a variety of music and non-musical areas.

*Campers who have completed gr. 8 have the choice of attending either or both Junior or Senior Divisions.
